


# "A Month of Praise!"

At the beginning of the month, we had our Arkansas Annual Conference Bishop, Laura Merrill, join us for Sunday morning worship at Goddard. This was her first time to Fort Smith and we made her first time a good experience. We had a wonderful time with Bishop Merrill, she is very approachable, and good things are ahead for our United Methodist Church in Arkansas.

This summer Wacky Wednesday kicked off and we have had 30 children participate over the weeks of this program so far. It has been a lot of fun and been so exciting to see so many children. It certainly has taken a great amount of energy, but thanks to Ms. Keri and several volunteers who have made this a wonderful connection to these children and their families.

We have had a wonderful time with our new Ballman Summer Program. Each Monday since June 4th, we have taken food bags from our food pantry, an assortment of children's books, and snack bags, for Ballman families to come and receive. Over the past month we have handed out 73 food bags and 100 snack bags. Every child gets to come and pick books they would like to take home. We must give thanks to the 200,000 More Reasons, Arkansas Conference program, which gave us \$6,000 towards this ministry and the launch of a Pop-up Library program to supply books to children for reading and literacy. Our Ballman Summer Program has been such a wonderful blessing so far. We have volunteers in the food pantry that help make extra food bags for this program, volunteers that help load these items in trucks and the church bus, and volunteers who hand out in the Ballman parking lot. Each week we have had a representative from the school, either a teacher, or the counselor, who volunteers with us. We are making a difference when the counselor says, "We love Goddard!"

Take a moment and realize all that has to go in to have the many things like this happen over this past month. It takes prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness. I thank each and every one of you who have in some way connected to Goddard this past month. Let's give God praise for so much that we get to be a part of, that we get to make a difference in people's lives.



God will allow me to look down on my enemies. 11 Don't kill them, or my people might forget; instead, by your power shake them up and bring them down, you who are our shield any my Lord. 12 For the sin of their mouths, the words that they speak, let them be captured in their pride. For the curses and lies they repeat, 13 finish them off in anger, finish them off until they are gone! Then let it be known to the ends of the earth that God rules over Jacob. 14 They come back every evening, growling like dogs, prowling around the city. 15 They roam about for food, and if they don't get their fill, they stay all night. 16 But me? I will sing of your strength! In the morning I will shout out loud about your faithful love because you have been my stronghold, my shelter when I was distraught. 17 I will sing praises to you, my strength, because God is my stronghold, my loving God.




# Goddard Food Pantry Report June 2023
