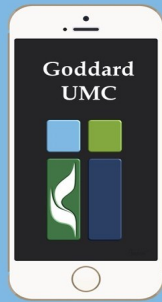


### Community Donations to Ballman Elementary

has reserved a section this summer on the Veritiv Home Plate Deck. This is an exclusive picnic table area located directly behind home plate and provides some of the best seats in the house.



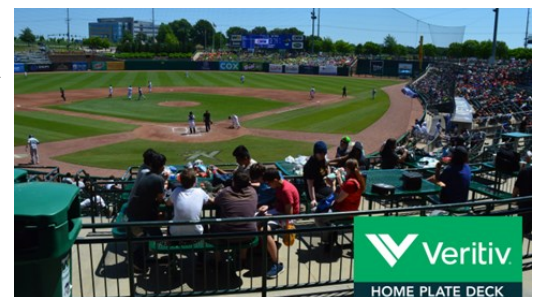

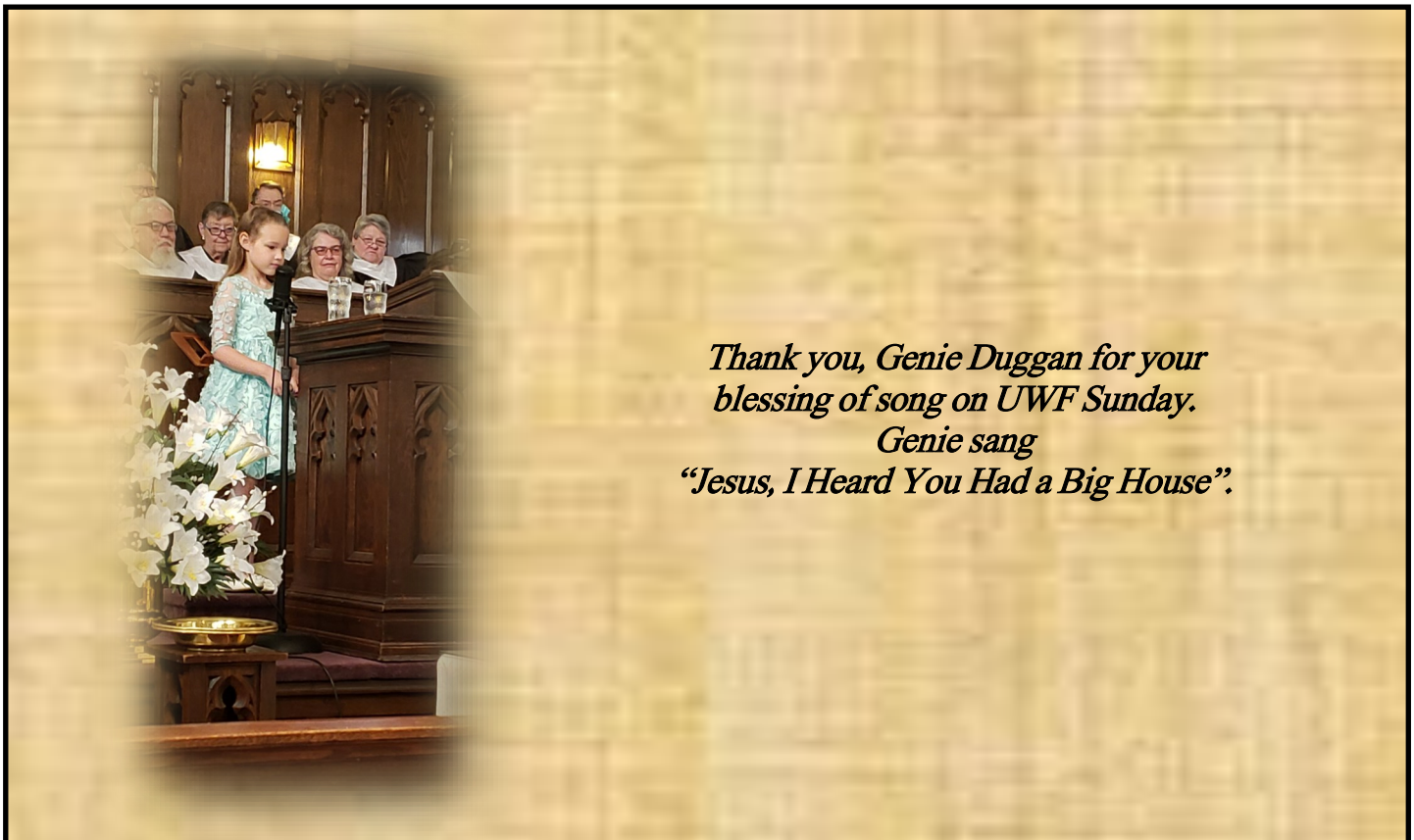

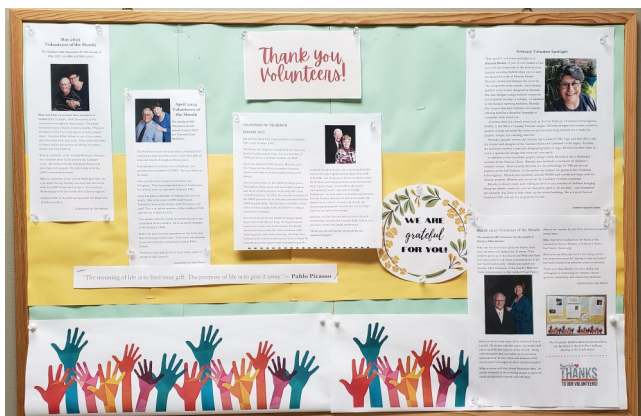
**BALLMAN SUMMER MISSION**

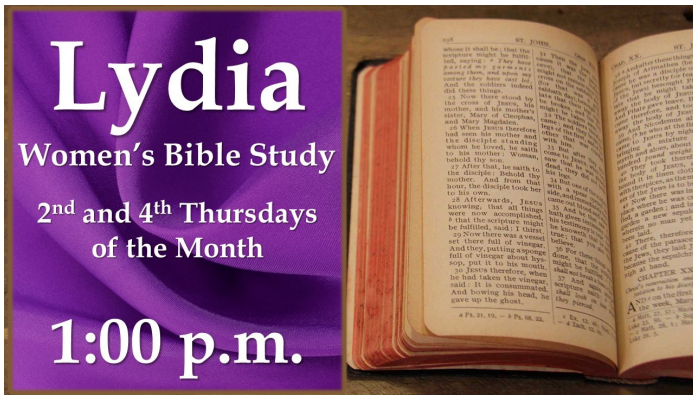
