

"Change is Hard"

The disciples were worried about the coming change. Jesus kept telling them what was going to happen—to be killed and raised on the third day. They didn't want that change. Perhaps they couldn't fathom the implications. Maybe like us, we just would rather have Jesus right next to us safe and nice and healing people. Jesus came for more, so much more. The change the disciples experienced over those three years of ministry, and experiencing the death and resurrection of our Lord, and up until the ascension began a transformation inside their hearts. What they became was courageous, faithful, vision-focused, and hopeful.

We've all heard it before that change is hard. We know that by experience. When schedules change sometimes it can be frustrating. Sometimes the change is for the better, but it is still an adjustment we have to weigh and configure into our life. We've had some positive change the last couple of months with new members joining. Change has settled in some ways as church activities have started back on Wednesday. More will start up this month with the return of MMM-Meal-Mission-Meditation, our monthly Wednesday fellowship time as a church, which is back on September 6th at 5:30.

And yes, more change still as we will be shifting our Sunday morning schedule. Why this change? Why change to a 9:50 Sunday school hour and a 10:50 worship service hour? We want to be more hospitable to our visitors, guests, and young families. Our Sunday school had children before church and youth after church, that just won't work for young families who have young ones in children and in youth. Two Sunday school times are difficult for newcomers to our church to have a way of really connecting. This move to 9:50 Sunday school and 10:50 worship service will be easier and cleaner to communicate to the folks not currently in our church. I met with various groups in the church about this and received feedback on this new time, many agreeable to this change, and our church council voted to confirm this new Sunday morning schedule that will launch September 10th.

So, mark your calendars—9:50 Sunday school, 10:50 Worship service. I pray this change won't be too frustrating for you and that in time it will be natural. I also want to encourage those who are not currently in a Sunday school, that now is a perfect time. With Sunday school being at 9:50, that is so close to what our regular worship time of 10:00 has been. So I would hope that you might try one of our Sunday schools to connect in that way.



As we navigate change of all kinds; our world, our bodies, our day to day, I pray that God would be our navigator through it all.

Philippians: To Live is Christ!






